How is Bail in Ogden, Utah Determined?

After an arrest, *the amount of bail will be set by a judge at the defendant's arraignment (bail hearing) and will be based on the severity of the alleged crime and the assessment*

of risk he or she poses to themselves and others. Depending on factors like the severity of the crime and the defendant's past record, bail can run from a few hundred dollars up to hundreds of thousands of dollars.

Once bail has been set, to get out of jail your next step is to post bail. Bail amounts can be expensive and paying the full amount may not be possible, this is where a reputable bail bond company can help. **At a fraction of the cost of the full bail amount you would be obligated to pay for release, the bail bonds company will issue a bond to the court for the bail amount.** The bail bondsman is then held liable if the defendant fails to appear in court.

What is a Bail Bond?

In Utah, a bail bond consists of a contract between the defendant, their consignee, and the bail bondsman. If a defendant cannot afford the bail amount set forth in the arraignment, a bail bond company can function as a guarantor between the court and the defendant. **The bond provides assurance to the court that, upon release, the defendant will be in attendance for their assigned court dates.** Here are the many different types of bail bonds and how they work:

- **Citation Release** - In cases like traffic violations, a *citation release occurs when a person is released immediately after being arrested by the presiding officer. A ticket is issued with instructions for the pending court appearance.*
- **Release on Your Own Recognizance** - When a defendant is *released from custody without payment, with a signed pledge to appear in court for a scheduled court date.* The defendant will incur a fee if the pledge is not honored or broken in any way.
- **Surety Bond** - A *surety bond is posted on the defendant's behalf by a third party, usually working with a bail bond company, who puts up collateral for the defendant's release.*
- **Property Bond** - *Property bonds are used as collateral for bail.* The property's value must be at least twice that of the dollar amount of the bail.
- **Cash Bond** - A *cash bond is set by the courts if a defendant is considered a flight risk.* The defendant or defendant's family pay the full bail amount to the court. The money is returned when the defendant shows up for the court, minus any court fees and other applicable charges.
- **Federal Bail Bond** - For crimes out of state jurisdiction, *a federal bail bond is an agreement with a third party with access to or who is in possession of proven assets to be used as collateral that will be forfeited if the defendant skips bail.*
- **Immigration Bond** - *An immigration bond is used for illegal aliens needing bail.* The process is complicated and is, therefore, the most expensive type of bail bond.

Bail is not offered for defendants who have committed capital crimes. Aside from the above-listed forms of bail, Utah residents also have the option to pay, in cash, the full bail amount to the court.
