

In Utah County, a bail bond is a legally binding agreement between the accused, their consignee, and the bailing party. ***The bail bond comes into play if the defendant is unable to afford the bail amount required by the law court.*** Our bail agents at [Bad Boys Bail Bonds](#) comes in as a bail sponsor between the defendant and the court.

***The bail bond is meant to assure the court that the defendant will still present himself/herself in court on the specified dates.*** The bail amount can run from a few hundred dollars to hundreds of thousands of dollars depending on several factors such as the defendant's record and the severity of the case.

## What Are the Common Types of Bail Bonds in Utah County?

---

***Here are some of the leading categories of bail bonds in Utah County and how they operate:***

- **Release on Your own Recognizance:** This is a type of bail bond in which the accused person is released from police custody without paying anything. However, the defendant is expected to sign a pledge that he/she will be present in court on the scheduled date. The defendant will pay a fine if the promise isn't honored.
- **Federal Bail Bond:** The federal bail bond applies to crimes outside the state jurisdiction. This is a legal agreement with a bail bond company with access to or who are already in possession of sizeable assets to be used as collateral security that will be forfeited if the defendant fails to present himself/herself in court on the scheduled dates.
- **Citation Release:** Typically, a citation release will only come into play if the defendant is released just after arrest. This type of a bail bond is usually common in cases such as traffic rule violations where the law protects the defendant from spending a night in custody.
- **Immigration Bond:** This type of bond is designed to help illegal immigration aliens who require bail. This is usually the most expensive type of bail since the process of acquiring it is complicated.
- **Surety Bond:** A surety bond will be posted on behalf of the accused individual by another third party working within Utah County bail company. The third party will be expected to provide collateral to facilitate the release of the defendant.

## **How Is a Bail Bond in Utah County Determined?**

---

After the arrest, the suspect will be presented in court for what is commonly referred to as the bail bond hearing session. The jury will listen to the facts and argument presented by the defendant and set an appropriate amount of the bail. The amount that the judge sets will be based on several factors such as the risk that the accused individual poses to other persons and the severity of the crime committed.

To be released, the individual must post the bail amount. Sometimes, the bail amount can be as high as hundreds of thousands of dollars which signifies the importance of bail companies such as the bad Boys Bail Bonds.
